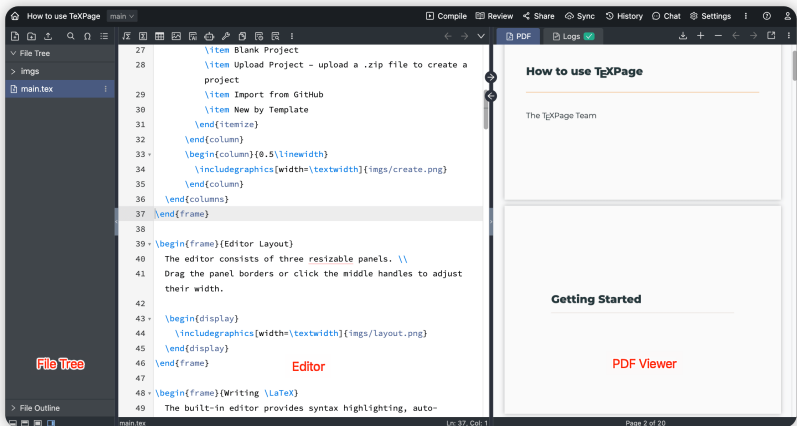

Drag the panel borders or click the middle handles to adjust their width.

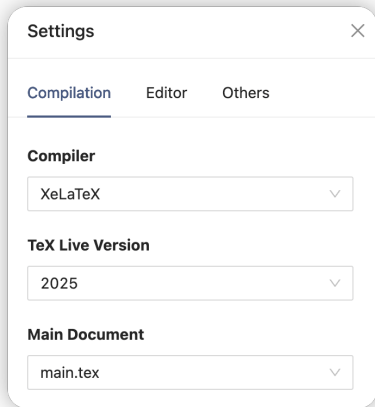

The built-in editor provides syntax highlighting, auto-completion, and other features.

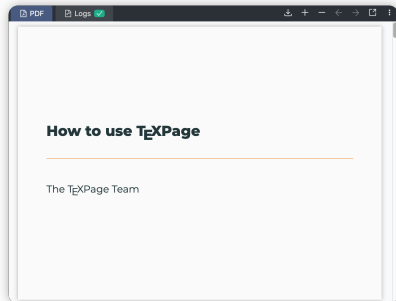

- Click **Settings** in the top toolbar
- Select the project's main file
- Choose the required compiler and \TeX Live version



- Click **Compile** in the top toolbar
- Windows: press **Ctrl + S** or **Ctrl + Enter**
- macOS: press **Command + S** or **Command + Enter**

- Zoom in/out
- Navigate using PDF outline
- Switch between fullscreen presentation and split view
- Double-click a PDF element to jump to the corresponding \LaTeX source



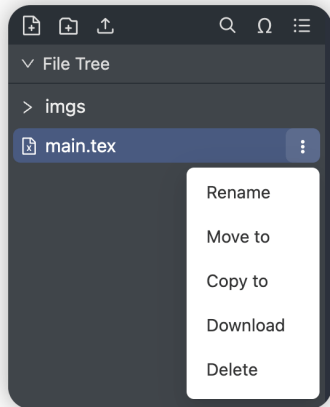
Compilation status is shown in the log panel above the PDF preview:

- **Red** - Errors
- **Orange** - Warnings
- **Green** Successful build (no errors/warnings)

To clear the build cache, click **Clear Cache** at the bottom of the log panel.

Managing Project Files


- Create, rename, or delete files and folders
- Upload files via drag-and-drop or paste
- Download project files
- Move files by dragging them within the file tree



Collaboration

Sharing Projects

- Click **Share** in the top toolbar
- Share via link or email
- Set permissions: Editor, Reviewer, Commenter, Viewer
- Manage collaborators directly in the sharing dialog

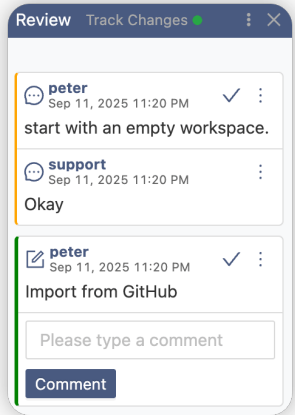

Review

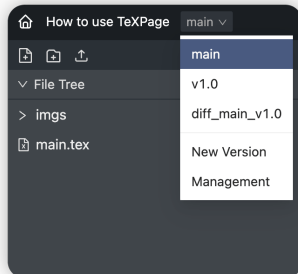
- Comments – add or reply to comments; resolved items can be reopened

Version Control

- Default version branch is main
- Versions are isolated from one another
- Save project versions at key milestones
- Review data is automatically included in new versions
- Compare versions and export a PDF showing tracked revisions
